The local event is open to the public and benefits Northampton Community College's culinary scholarship program. **Entrees are judged on taste, appearance, and originality.** The 1<sup>st</sup> place winner will be eligible to represent Pennsylvania in the 2011 National Pork Board's Taste of Elegance Chef Competition to be confirmed at a later date.
